Presentation of the project:

In these times of quick development of ICTs and growing offer of e-services, number of European citizens, notably with less opportunity (elderly people, migrants, unemployed persons, young people...), are demanding for assistance to access ICTs. One of the issues at stake is to enable the access to ICTs so as to develop the people’s social inclusion; to reach a level of digital literacy that can develop people’s employability, health, democratic participation and well-being.

Professionals already exist in this field: the multimedia facilitators handle competences in both IC technologies and social inclusion, which they often developed through their professional experience. The common weakness observed is that in Europe, those actors are not recognized enough as professionals in e-Inclusion. The common European objective is therefore to create and to recognize a training curriculum of e-facilitator for social inclusion.

This statement is at the heart of the project: working in partnership to prove that the profession exists and that there is a common European need for the e-Facilitator to be recognized as a professional. The project actually creates a training curriculum for e-facilitator for social inclusion, with a phase of pilot-courses tests through e-learning, reaching more than 400 European learners.
